


2013-2023 Donations






Issues affecting primary care in Serbia and BH:

- Infrastructure in disrepair
- Out-dated or inexistent equipment
- Patients have to pay out-of-pocket for certain services or medications not covered by the public healthcare system
- Rural areas often have limited access to local healthcare facilities or services, leading to longer travel times for medical services
- There is a shortage of medical professionals, leading to longer waiting times for appointments and poor service
- Bureaucracy










































2022 Chicago fundraiser: \$126,000

What was done:

- 1. Replaced/repaired sewer pipes
- 2. Replaced ceiling
- 3. Remodel nonfunctional bathrooms and patient wardrobe
- 4. Replaced floors
- 5. Repair and replacement of electrical circuit and lighting
- 6. Paint walls, windows and radiators
- 7. Donation of 22 new hospital beds, including weighing beds (for
- patients unable to stand) along with hosp furniture
- 8. EKC
- 9. Ultrasound with vascular and abdominal probes.

Project Cost: \$168,968.37











